6. Read Daniel 1:12-16, 10:1-3. Have you ever been so bothered by the spiritual conditions around you that you went without food...so that you could be devoted to prayer? Give an example. What bothered you? Are you broken and bothered now to the point of prayer and fasting? What is it that you need to hear the voice of God about?

## Becoming Attractive

- I. Attraction is a drawing power. (John 6:44; Acts 2:47)
- II. How do we increase our drawing power?
  - A. We must prioritize wisely. (Acts 2:42-46)
    1. Heaven to Earth communication.  
(John 5:17-20; I Kings 22:17-20)
      - a. Prayer shows our desires and dependence  
for a father/child partnership. (Daniel 1:12-16, 10:1-3)
  - B. Once a daily partnership is established, expect to be used  
in a supernatural way.
    1. The God nudge: the inner push that directs us  
toward a person, place or action.
    2. The revealing cue: is communicated by someone's  
words or body language.
    3. The clarifying bump: gives us insight into a person's need.
    4. The Spirit prompt: a sudden insight about a person you  
are helping.
    5. The alert: a reliable indicator that you should exercise  
your faith.
