9. What does your daily prayer life look like? On average, how much time did we pray as a group in 2009? Are we ok with that for 2010? Read Matthew 21:18-22. If we expect God to do great things, we need to commit great times of prayer. How does that look for our group?

4. Why doesn't the church today have this kind of unity? What are some things that are keeping this group from being totally unified? Are these areas the same at THRIVE on Monday nights—why or why not?

5. What does living in expectation and unity have to do with what God will or won't do for our group in 2010?

6. Read Hebrews 10:24-25. What was the urgency of the early Christians meeting together? What do you think are some areas that the early Christians need encouraging in? How do we need to be encouraged today?
