10. Read Acts 8:26-29. Do you have a discerning faith? Share a time in the last few weeks you clearly heard the Holy Spirit tell you something? How did you respond?

11. Read Acts 8:30-35. Do you know of anyone who has a seeking faith? Why or why not?

12. Read Acts 8:36-40. Do you have a radical faith? Why or why not? What does it take to have a radical faith? Are you willing to surrender to a radical faith? What do you need to give up to be in the radical faith?
