1. Do you think most Christians know their purpose in life? Why or why not? Do you think those who do know their purpose in life stay focused on it? Why or why not?

2. Read Acts 13:1, Matthew 28:19&20, Acts 1:8. What is the purpose here? Has the Church been accomplishing the purpose? Why or why not? Are you? Is your community group?

3. Read Acts 13:1, Ephesians 4:11&12, Romans 12:3-8. Do you work as a team when it comes to your spiritual gifts? Do you even understand working as a body of differing gifts with one purpose? What about your community group?

4. Read Acts 13:2a and Numbers 2:2. Do you think most Christians live with God at the center of all they do? Why? Do you? Why?

5. Read Exodus 19:4-6, 20:18-20. Why do people avoid God in certain areas of their life? Are there areas you avoid Him? Do you believe most Christians realize that God desires to be involved in their life? Why do you think God wants to be involved? Has there been a time you avoided God and paid for it in a costly way? Give example.

6. Look at the Hebrew word and the Greek word for worship. Would you say your relationship with God is balanced with passion and intimacy? Why or why not?

7. Look at Psalms 34:1, 63:4, 47:1, Habbakuk 2:20, Acts 3:8, and Psalms 150:3-5. Do you find it easy or hard to express your love in any of the above forms. What about your community group and Keystone Fellowship celebration service?
