5. Read 2 Corinthians 4:7-10. What are some hardships in Paul's life? Why do you think he shares them with us? How do these verses make you feel?

6. Read 2 Timothy 3:12. How is this a true statement for your life? How can you prepare for persecution? What verses from God's Word come to mind when you are in the midst of it?
