I. There was a day when up became **DOWN** and down became **UP**. (Genesis 2:15-18; Genesis 3:6-10)

A. Their living right side up: (I Thessalonians 1:3-4; I Thess. 4:1)

1) **COURAGE**. (Acts 17:1-2a, 10; Acts 20:23-24)

2) **FAITH** produces courage. (Acts 17:4-9, 12)

3) **HEARING** produces faith. (Acts 17:2-3, 11; Luke 24:32)
