5. How would you define a volunteer? What are things we volunteer for? Read Acts 16:9&10. Did Paul see himself as a volunteer? Read Galatians 1:15. How did Paul see himself? Do you see yourself as a volunteer or a called person chosen by God? How do most Christians see themselves? Read I Corinthians 9:16. Do you feel compelled to share the gospel? Why?

6. Read Acts 15:36. What do you think is a go-back relationship according to Paul? Read 16:1. Do you have any Timothys in your life? Read I Corinthians 4:15. Why do you think there are so few spiritual fathers? What does a father look like and do?

7. Read Acts 16:2&3. Do people speak well of you as a follower of Christ? Are you serving on a team?
